Gratitude House has had a successful career of many “firsts” in South Florida.

They were the first to open a women’s-only treatment center, the first to implement an integrated HIV / AIDS chemical dependency program, the first in Palm Beach County to allow infants to reside with mothers in primary treatment and the first of many more achievements.

Founded in 1968, Gratitude House Inc. is a nonprofit organization that is dedicated to offering rehabilitation and support services with dignity and respect to women in a nurturing, safe and caring environment.

Gratitude House strives daily to return its program

participants to society as self-sufficient, productive citizens.

Since 1992, The Able Trust has granted more than \$955,000 to nonprofit agencies that support employment-related programs for people with disabilities in Palm Beach County.
